"We're having a blast and having so many girls together gives us a fantastic opportunity to attempt some all-female records and to take some new recruits into the air.

"Skysisters is a great opportunity to come and have a go and try skydiving for yourself.

"We had a three-generation jump which was amazing so you can even bring your nana and have a try."

The girls have already done hundreds of jumps including Easter themed jumps.

The record attempts are expected to take place in the next few days when the girls have had a chance to practice together.

The event, which is open to the public and free for spectators, has also attracted an impressive list of attendees from within the skydiving fraternity including Kate Cooper-Jensen from California who has completed over 9500 jumps and holds 14 world records and cinematographer, Norman Kent who is responsible for filming skydiving scenes.
